BY ACCESSING THE LANDSUPPORT WEB PLATFORM AND USING THE LANDSUPPORT WEB APPLICATION, THE USER ACCEPTS THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS AGREEMENT.USE OF THE LANDSUPPORT WEB PLATFORM INDICATES HAVING READ, UNDERSTOOD AND ACCEPTED THIS AGREEMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH HERE WITHIN.THE FINAL VERSION OF THE PLATFORM WILL ONLY BE FULLY AVAILABLE AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE PROJECT AND, THEREFORE, ALL PREVIOUS VERSIONS ARE TO BE CONSIDERED AS SIMPLY DEMOS.THE LANDSUPPORT CONSORTIUM ALSO RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MODIFY THE PRODUCT AT ANY TIME AND WITHOUT NOTICE.

1.ACCESS

We do not charge for access to the web platform, which is open and free for everyone. However, this competence reduces, but does not eliminate, the intrinsic uncertainty of the evaluations.

LANDSUPPORT is a multi-scale decision support system. Each of the 15 available tools is designed for a specific application and a specific scale. Furthermore, the databases (which can be consulted in the system) refer to a theme (e.g. geology, soil, land use etc.) and the maps generated from the databases were obtained - through either analogical or digital methods — by using the specific standards required for each specific scale. The information content of these maps is reported in the metadata available in the system. These metadata must be consulted by the user before he/she uses the system.

As a consequence of this, users of the LANDSUPPORT web platform must be aware of any limitations within the

different maps that they wish to make use of for their specific application. Users must be (or should become) experts in their specific field and must understand whether the input data and model offered by the platform are suitable to their specific requirements. This task can be greatly simplified by studying the technical sheet of tools available at www.landsupport.eu and related publications. If users are uncertain of whether the input data and model are appropriate, they should either abandon the use of the platform or consult the LANDSUPPORT team. The system provides very reliable results only when used appropriately. Indeed, an erroneous evaluation of data and model can only lead to erroneous results.

Therefore, each user is responsible for his/her use of the platform and the evaluation of whether the tool fits his/her purpose.

For instance, the European Soil data base at 1:1,000,000 (ESDAC) should preferably be used at continental scales; use at national and regional scales could mislead. In order to give an insight into what is behind the use of a specific standard and scale, examples are given of standards employed in soil survey and conventional soil mapping in the table below (Terribile et al., 2011).

When using the LANDSUPPORT web platform for detailed analysis at regional and local scales, the initial planning calls for use of geospatial data which is considered appropriate, but precise site and soil evaluation needs field analysis and evaluation.

In terms of the models, although it is not necessary for users to know about the mechanisms and algorithms behind a model, they should, however, be aware of the main limitations and purposes of any model applied. Consequently, each model will be accompanied by a brief cautionary note.
